# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- Target Corp (Nov-Dec 2013)
  - 70 M demographics stolen (ID)
  - 40 M CC stolen
  - Auto-issuance of new CC and DC cards.
  - Offered credit monitoring for one year,

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- Neiman Marcus (July-Oct 2013)
  - 350,000 CC stolen, 9K used fraudulently
- Michael's / Aaron Brothers (May 2013-Jan '14)
  - 2.6 M CC affected, (400K in AB)
  - Vulnerability included POS terminals as entry point for exploit.

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- Ebay (Feb-Mar 2014) – 233 M cust affected.
  - Vulnerability included old passwords for employee login credentials.
  - Public statement asking all users to change pw, (<https://www.ebayinc.com/stories/news/ebay-inc-ask-ebay-users-change-passwords?>)

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- PF Changs China Bistro (Sept 2013-June '14)
  - 33 restaurants affected, ID info sold.
- UPS (Jan-Aug 2014)
  - 60+ UPS Stores affected including CC #s
  - Result of **Backoff POS malware...**

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- Home Depot (Sept 2014)
  - 56 M cust CC affected, 2K stores in NA.
- Goodwill Ind Intl (Feb 2013-Aug 2014)
  - 868,000 CC/DC#s stolen from 330 stores
  - Malware suspected through 3<sup>rd</sup> party vendors

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- SuperValu (*Cub Foods, Shop&Save, FarmFresh*)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> attack June/July 2014
  - Malware affected cust data and CC data
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> attack late Aug/Sept 2014
  - Only payment card data affected.

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- JP Morgan Chase (financial retail)
  - Attack in June 2014, not noticed till Aug.
  - 76 M households, 7M smallbiz affected
  - Hackers likely orig from Russia
  - Suspected ties to Russian govt

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Scope and Magnitude (Continued)**
- Dairy Queen Intl / Orange Julius smoothies
  - 395 restaurants affected, CC/DC stolen
  - Backoff malware suspected... (again!)

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Cultural Norms in 21<sup>st</sup> Century – ID Theft**
- As we see more retail outlets hacked and more consumer data compromised, a new de facto norm is created re: Personally Identifiable Info
- Some cultural references: Hollywood movies
  - The Net (1995); The Jackal (1997), Ocean's 11 (2001) et al.; Mission Impossible franchise (1996, 2000, 2006, 2011, 2015); Catch Me If You Can (2002), Identity Thief (2013).

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Cultural Norm – Precautions & Resolutions**
- Websites using cookies; user acceptance rate
- Email promotions and spam
- FBI and other agencies involved
  - Creation of academic programs such as ours –  
*Dr. Johnson's background with USSS NY and SanFran  
field offices, FBI, Electronic Crime Task Force... -*

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Cultural Norm – Precautions & Resolutions**
- What can you do as a consumer?
  - Check credit rating **free once per year**
    - AnnualCreditRating.com (per FTC)
  - Monitor accounts periodically for abuse.
  - Don't ignore consumer warnings on media regarding ID breach attacks.

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Cultural Norm – Precautions & Resolutions**
- What can the government do?
  - FBI Cyber Division (since 2002)
    - Heads national effort to investigate and prosecute internet crimes including “...terrorism, espionage, intrusions and major fraud”
  - Immigrations & Customs Enforcement (DHS)
    - Cyber Crimes Center (C3) – *Formed 1998*

# Cybersecurity In The Retail Sector

- **Cultural Norm – Precautions & Resolutions**

  - Retail and online shopping precautions
  - DC/CC safety, banks and agencies offer protection (such as Lifelock, ProtectMyID/Experian in the case of Target)
  - CC: fraud protection - “did not buy that”, vs. DC safety
  - Annual credit check and basic personal finance safety – monitor your purchases (usu. 30-60 days, varies by bank).
